Local Dining Fundraiser Fights AIDS in Hawai'i on Wednesday, March 4th

Honolulu, HI – February 17, 2009 – The 6th annual Oahu Dines charity event will be held on Wednesday, March 4th. Oahu Dines is a benefit for Life Foundation, a local organization dedicated to fighting AIDS in Hawaii and the Pacific. On March 4th, participating restaurants will donate a portion of their proceeds to support Life Foundation's work and promote HIV/AIDS awareness in Hawaii. Currently, 18 restaurants are signed on to participate.

Life Foundation provides free services to more than 600 men, women and children living with HIV/AIDS on Oahu while offering free HIV testing and education to the community.

Boots and Kimo's Homestyle Restaurant, Big City Diner-Ward, and Diamond Head Market and Grill have signed up at the Platinum Plate Sponsor level, committing a minimum of \$1,500 of sales.
